Although the Council regards the provision of a school crossing patrol service as an important contribution to the safety of children in County Durham, this provision is a permissive function rather than a statutory obligation of the council and it must be appreciated that parental responsibility is in no way diminished by the exercise of this service.

We continue remind parents & carers to exercise care when sending their children to school, remembering that some children may not be able to assess traffic speed and distance, and may experience difficulty in crossing certain roads on their own.
